the autobiography of an ex colored man by james weldon johnson is the fictional telling of the story of a young biracial man

referred to only as the ex colored man living in post reconstruction era america in the late nineteenth and early twentieth century the ex colored man was forced to choose between embracing his black heritage and culture by expressing himself through the african american musical genre ragtime or by passing and living obscurely as a mediocre middle class white man the ex colored man living in an all black community discovered three classes of blacks the desperate class the domestic service class and the independent workman johnson originally wrote the autobiography of an ex colored man anonymously in 1912 by the small new york publisher sherman french and company brandon s decision to publish the novel anonymously stemmed in part from his sense that signing his name to a potentially controversial book might damage his diplomatic career

james weldon johnson june 17 1871 june 26 1938 was an american author educator lawyer diplomat songwriter and civil rights activist johnson is best remembered for his leadership of the national association for the advancement of colored people naacp where he started working in 1917 in 1920 he was the first african american to be chosen as executive secretary of the organization effectively the operating officer he served in that position from 1920 to 1930 johnson established his reputation as a writer and was known during the harlem renaissance for his poems novels and anthologies collecting both poems and spirituals of black culture he was appointed under president theodore roosevelt as us consul in venezuela and nicaragua for most of the period from 1906 to 1913 in 1934 he was the first african american professor to be hired at new york university later in life he was a professor of creative literature and writing at fisk university ohnson was born in 1871 in jacksonville florida the son of helen louise dillet a native of nassau bahamas and james johnson his maternal great grandmother hester argo had escaped from saint domingue during the revolutionary upheaval in 1802 along with her three young children including james s grandfather stephen dillet 1797 1880 although originally headed to cuba their boat was intercepted by privateers and they were taken to nassau bahamas where they permanently settled in 1833 stephen dillet became the first man of color to win election to the bahamian legislature ref james weldon johnson along this way his

james weldon johnson june 17 1871 june 26 1938 was an american author politician diplomat critic journalist poet anthologist educator lawyer songwriter and early civil rights activist johnson was born in jacksonville florida on june 17th 1871 his early education was at home from his mother helen a musician and a public school teacher the first female black teacher in florida at a grammar school and then at edwin m stanton school at 16 his education moved to atlanta university graduating with a degree in 1894 this classical education gave johnson the impetus to put his life to work for the benefit of black people in

1904 Johnson helped in Theodore Roosevelt's presidential bid. On winning, Roosevelt appointed him as US Consul at Puerto Cabello, Venezuela from 1906-1908 and then Nicaragua from 1909-1913. During his work in Nicaragua, he married Grace Nail, whom he had met in New York a few years earlier. Whilst writing songs, his career spanned several elements: education, the diplomatic corps, civil rights activism, literature, poetry, and music. Johnson worked for the NAACP from 1916 as a field secretary, organizing local chapters to counter race riots and lynchings. He organized mass demonstrations such as a silent protest parade of over ten thousand African Americans down New York's Fifth Avenue on July 28, 1917. In 1920, Johnson was elected to manage the NAACP, the first African American to hold this position. That same year, he was dispatched to monitor conditions in Haiti and described in *The Nation* the brutal occupation and also offered remedies. During the 20s, he was one of the major inspirations of the Harlem Renaissance. In the midst of all this, he continued to write novels, poems, and folklore. In 1917, he saw published *50 Years and Other Poems*. In 1922, he edited the book *Book of American Negro Poetry*, which the Academy of American Poets calls a major contribution to the history of African American literature. In 1927, he followed *God's Trombones: Seven Negro Sermons in Verse*. James Weldon Johnson died on June 26th, 1938, whilst vacationing in Wiscasset, Maine. His car was hit by a train.
